

A Simplified Land Use Map for the Kittybrewster Area of Aberdeen



Land use mapping in the Kittybrewster area revealed a largely residential area with some significant areas of industry. There were also two areas of open space which was quite surprising for the location relative to the CBD.

Mixed Housing and Industry in Kittybrewster



Well established water industry on the same street as tenements, which could originally have housed workers for local industry.

Small scale industries and garages



Tenements and low order shops and services to serve the dense population of the area



Modern Infill housing

Evidence of the improvement of the area with modern infill housing giving householders good access to local services, easy access to jobs in the CBD and a pleasant estate to live in. The streets have speed restricting bumps, houses have gardens and garages. The roads are free from through traffic.



Brownfield Site Redevelopment – Furniture Stores, a Supermarket and an Area Ready for <u>Redevelopment</u>

This area is designed for shoppers with cars. There is plenty of car parking space. The shops sell a variety of goods from food to flooring, from bed linen to sports equipment.


Brownfield site; housing association flats built on the site of the former mart



This site needs to be redeveloped. The old industry has declined and a derelict building is left. This large site could be used as a brownfield site – for housing or industry. It is close to a lot of housing and on a main road, so it has good access.



The Environmental Survey for Kittybrewster



- The area was landscaped with trees
- There was no derelict land
- The environment was not bad as there was no litter and no vandalism
- In my survey area there was no industry all the buildings were residential but I know that in nearby streets there was industrial land use.
- The traffic flow was as expected for a central location but higher than an area such as Dyce, so the area was quite noisy.
- There was good provision of shops and services

- This area is very built up, many of the houses were old and included terraces and tenements.
- There was no landscaping and there was little open space
- Housing and industry were close together and not in distinct areas
- There were a lot of services for the people living in the area from small low order convenience shops to large supermarkets and furniture stores
