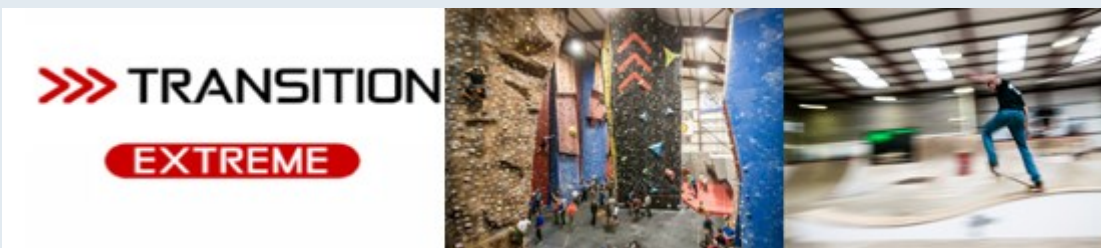

Wednesday 8th May– Friday 10th May.

Each pupil, not already going on a residential trip, will have been given an Activities Day Trip/In-school Choice Form to complete, indicating which activities they would prefer to take part in.

Pupils should select a first and reserve choice for each activity selected.

Please note activities will only run if there are sufficient numbers. In the event that an activity is over-subscribed, priority will go to older pupils as this will be their final chance to participate in Activities Days.

Please make sure you discuss with your parents/ guardians before you submit the form.

All pupils **MUST** return their form to their registration teacher **by Friday 1st March 2019.**

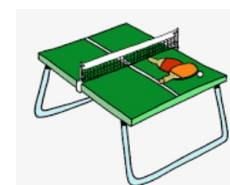

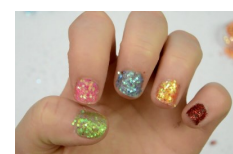
In the Kitchen ~ Calling all budding chefs. If you enjoy cooking and eating then this is the activity for you. Friday is curry day - madras or korma your choice.
