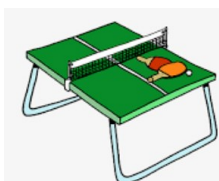

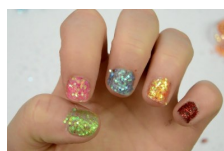
Yarn / Weaving ~ Learn to crochet, weave and make bracelets.
