

PUPIL SELECTION

There are limited spaces available for each trip, so unfortunately it may not be possible to secure your first choice of activity. We will, however, ask for reserve options and we ask for your understanding where this is the case.

For anyone who is not successful in securing a place on a residential trip, you will be included in the options process for the in school and Day Trips during Activities Week.

For those pupils who select a residential trip, we will ask you to indicate your choices in order of preference. Priority for residential trips will be given to S3 pupils, and we will also take account of those who have already had a residential experience last session. Where spaces remain on residential trips, we will then look at the choices made by our S2 and S1 pupils. This allocation process will continue in future years to ensure an equitable approach.

Our aim is to ensure that pupils have a variety of experiences over the three years of Activities Days experiences.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

We are very aware of the rise in the cost of living at present, and we have taken this into consideration in our planning.

In addition to the residential offer outlined in this booklet, we will also offer a range of activities in school with varying cost levels, including ones where no costs will be incurred.

We have also included on the following page details of the Aberdeenshire Educational Trust Grant which can be accessed to provide financial support. For those pupils who are allocated a residential trip, the trip leader will subsequently be in contact to request the initial deposit which is required to secure your child's place.

Information will then be shared regarding a remaining payment schedule for this experience.

TRAVEL GRANT INFORMATION

Most pupils who live within the Dyce Academy catchment area should be eligible to apply for an Aberdeenshire Educational Trust grant.

Partial cost of day trips and residential trips can all be applied for through this fund. One application per academic year can be made, per pupil.

Please be advised that the deposit will have to be paid by parents / carers, prior to the grant being aproved to secure your child's place.

The deposit will cover the costs for the trip that are not covered by the grant.

Work Experience provides pupils the chance to experience what it is like to be part of a work force giving them the opportunity to explore areas of interest or future career path options.

Pupils would be required to source their own work experience placement with the support of parents/carers. This will allow for greater personalisation and choice. This could extend from 3 days to the full week, depending on individual circumstances.

We also have the option of a work experience placement for our S3 pupils during this time.

At Dyce Academy we feel that Activities Days are an important part of a young person's journey through school. Participation in Activities Days is about enhancing every young persons educational experience, helping them to develop their skills set and build their confidence as they move through the Broad General Education years.

We have also included an overview of the Work Experience option which is specifically for our S3 pupils.

Finally, you will find the residential trips which will be on offer along with their estimated cost and proposed itinerary.

Please be advised that in all cases activities will only run if there are sufficient numbers to make it viable.

At this stage, what we are looking to find out is whether you wish to participate in the in school and day trip option, the work experience option, or whether you want to be considered for a residential experience. All options should be discussed with parents/carers before making your choices.
